


Sake Cups

Overview of Common Sake Cup Styles



Guinomi

- Generally larger sized sake cups
- · May have a rougher, organic texture and shape
- Common Material: Ceramic






- · Square box shape
- Standard size: 180ml / 6 oz. in volume
- Common Material: Wood



- Shallow, wide bowl shape.
- · Often used for ceremonial purposes
- · Common Materials: Wood/Lacquer, Metal



Kikichoko




- Often used by industry and professional tasters
- · Common Material: Ceramic



Kiriko Glass

- Faceted, ornate cut glass designs often colored blue or red
- Famously produced in Edo (Tokyo) & Satsuma (Kagoshima)
- Common Material: Glass





- Often with a smooth texture and shape
- Common Materials: Glass, Ceramic, Metal, Wood/Lacquer



Footed Cup

- Both modern and historial designs
- · Usually rounded cups with a raised foot
- · Common Materials: Glass, Ceramic
